How many words can you think of that rhyme with cat? dog?


<u>l spy...</u>

The Activity Odd one out - Sorting

Find a group of 4 objects which each have one thing that makes them different from the other.



For example, in the shapes above the circle could be the odd one out because it is a different shape from the others. The green triangle is a different colour and the small triangle is a different size. Encourage your child to explain their reasoning.

The Activity

Spot my mistake – exploring pattern Show your child a pattern that has a deliberate mistake. What do they notice?



Ask your child to suggest ways to sort out the problem. They might swap the items around which means they will need to continue amending the pattern until the end of the line. Understanding the world.
