Welcome to Year 4! Welcome back to our returning children and a very warm welcome to any new families joining Yerbury this year.

Our topic for Autumn 1 is **Ancient Greece**, which has a history focus. In Autumn 2, our topic is **Active Planet**, a geography-based unit that explores plate tectonics and natural phenomena such as earthquakes and volcanoes. The majority of the learning will take place during history or geography lessons, but as always, we will make connections across the curriculum - for example, through art and English activities inspired by our topic. We are really looking forward to exploring these exciting topics with the children.

What to bring to school:

Children should ideally bring a labelled water bottle to school each day. They can bring a suitable packed lunch which they are expected to be able to eat independently and within the allocated time; they should be able to open flasks, etc. on their own. Our school is a healthy eating school. This means that packed lunches should be healthy and balanced, with no sweets, chocolate, crisps or fizzy drinks. There should also be strictly no nuts in any lunches or snacks brought into school.

Additionally, children can bring a reading book from home to read in school each day and they may take books from the classroom home with them as long as they are brought back to school.

Medicines:

Please make sure we have two sets of medication for your child if they need it. (EpiPen, inhalers, etc) and ensure you have filled in the required forms at the office. Any medication held in school from last year should be checked to ensure it has not expired. Please replace any medication that is no longer within date and inform the school of any changes to your child's medical needs.

Homework:

We will be sending home weekly spelling homework and children should also practice online using their Spelling Shed account. Children are also expected to practise times tables using the Times Tables Rockstars website/app. Teachers will be regularly monitoring the children's effort and engagement. We recommend that your child should play for at least ten minutes per day and five days a week.
